



KIT #1 — HONEY PIE (to knit)

Who doesn't need a little honey in their life? The Honey Pie pattern by Lisa Chemery is a cute little pinafore that is easy to knit and has some thoughtful details to make it something special for your little Honey. This dress is worked seamlessly in the round, from the bottom-up, then the front and back are worked flat separately. It features an I-cord edging, picot hem and box pleats among other techniques. All are helpfully explained in the pattern. There are two openings at the sides, fastened with buttons. Simple cables are worked on either side of the front of the dress and continue along the straps.

There are 4 button holes as well, giving you a chance to add yet another personal touch to your finished garment. Lofty Lou's carries a ton of button options, so you'll have fun picking out just the right ones for your project.

The Honey Pie pattern (€6 or about \$7 USD) includes sizes starting 3 mos up to 6 years.

We've paired this pattern with Malabrigo Rios (210 yards/skein). The sample is pictured in the color Frank Ochre but we have lots of colors in stock. A sampling is here. Rios is 100% superwash wool yarn that is very soft. You'll need 2 or 3 skeins depending on the size you make.
