



Serin Tee Kit *to crochet* — \$40.00-\$74.00

So pretty worn over a coordinating tank or camisole, this lacy tee by designer Tian Connaughton uses a simple filet pattern (technique combining open and closed mesh stitches), making it an ideal pullover for warm weather. It's worked in 2 pieces from the bottom up, with a slight drape at the front neckline. Suggested hook size: J. Skill Level: Advanced beginner/intermediate.

For your tee you'll use **Huasco Cotón**, a hand-dyed, fingering-weight yarn from Araucania (481yd/hank). It's cool, 100% cotton, soft, and lightweight—what more could you ask for in a summer top? Your tank will use 900-1980 yards, depending on size crocheted.

Kit includes printed pattern plus 2-4 hanks of Huasco Cotón for \$40.00 to \$74.00 (depending on size).
