

Sunshine Lace Scarf – to Knit (2/15/22)

Punch up your late-winter-into-spring wardrobe with this light and airy scarf. **Sunshine Lace**, by designer **Tian Connaughton**, combines vertical lines and a delicate, open pattern to create an accessory you'll want to reach for every day. It's worked in a single piece from the bottom up, beginning and ending in garter stitch at the edges. The scarf is easy to adjust in width and length by adding or removing multiples of nine stitches and working fewer or more rows. Recommended for intermediate knitters; suggested needle size: US 4.

This pattern is paired with one of our newest yarns, **Malabrigo Silkpaca**, a cloudlike blend of baby alpaca and silk. It has just a bit of halo and despite being lace weight, this luxurious yarn is plied and sturdy (420yds/hank).
